MOBY ON ANGELES CREST HIGHWAY IN LOS ANGELES



The musician **MOBY** has eaten a vegan diet for nearly three decades. “Being vegan 28 years ago was akin to being a space alien,” he says. Now chefs everywhere are giving vegetables star treatment on their menus. So, too, is Moby. He’s opening the vegan bistro Little Pine in the Silver Lake neighborhood of LA. It’s intended to be an all-day place, going from 7:30 a.m. until midnight

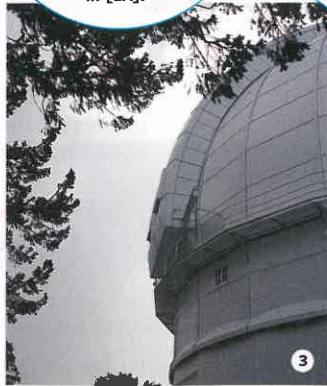
or 1 a.m. and serving dishes such as mushroom-leek potpie and lemon-mint-pea pâté. “The goal is not to rely on fake meats,” he says. “We want to create beautiful, relatively normal food that just happens to be vegan.” Moby, who has been a photographer as long as he’s been a musician, is also responsible for the photos on the walls. “Every last detail I’ve chosen,” he says. —**MATT MCCUE**

Switzer Falls
“Go there and have a picnic. The last time I was up there, I saw a giant bear. Where else in the world can you have a picnic in a city and run the risk of seeing a bear?”
